He has been a faculty member in the School of Community and Regional Planning, the Westwater Research Centre and the Institute for Resources, Environment and Sustainability. Outside of UBC he was the founding Chair of the Fraser Basin Management Board (1992-94) and a member of the BC Round Table on Environment and Economy (1990-94). His contributions have been recognized by a Killam Faculty Research Fellowship (1988), the University Teaching Prize (1995), the 2000 Professional Award of the Canadian Water Resources Association of BC, and election as a Fellow of the Canadian Institute of Planners (2007).

Everyone who has worked with Tony over the last four decades is invited to join us. Come and hear Tony express his appreciation to all those who have helped him and join with a panel of students, faculty, alumni, planning practitioners and citizens in expressing appreciation for all he has done.
